



OPERATION

- Installing the battery – The battery is accessed below the objective or front-end lens. The battery cap [E] is removed by rotating the cap in the counterclockwise (CCW) direction. Remove the cap and insert a fresh AAA battery positive (+) end first. The negative (-) should be facing outward. Replace the battery cap by rotating the cap clockwise (CW) until finger tight.
- Power - To turn sight on press and hold either (+) or (-) button on the top. To turn sight off press and hold (-) button.
- The sight features MOTAC™. It will automatically turn off after 120 seconds of inactivity. As soon as the sight senses motion it will automatically power back on to the current setting.
- Brightness Control - To increase or decrease the reticle brightness tap (+) or (-) button on top. Sight has 10 day time and 2 NV settings.
- Reticle Selection (XDR Models Only) - With sight powered on, press and hold both (+) and (-) buttons simultaneously. This will scroll through available reticle options. Release to lock-in desired reticle.

MOUNTING THE SIGHT

- This product is designed for 1.41" absolute co-witness and intended for use on most types of firearms with MIL-STD 1913 Picatinny Rail. With infinite eye relief, the sight can be mounted anywhere on the rail; forward or back.
- To install the sight on a firearm, set the mount on the Rail at your preferred eye relief, push the sight forward into the rail lugs and torque the half-inch nut [F] to 65 in-lbs.

SIGHT ADJUSTMENTS

- Elevation adjustments - Using provided multi-tool, coin, or shell casing, turn the Elevation Adjustment [D] counterclockwise (CCW) to move Point of Impact (POI) UP. To move POI DOWN, rotate clockwise (CW). Each click moves POI 1 MOA.
- Windage Adjustments - Using provided multi-tool, coin or shell casing, turn the Windage Adjustment [C] counterclockwise (CCW) to move POI RIGHT. To move POI LEFT, rotate clockwise (CW). Each click moves POI 1 MOA.

MAINTENANCE

CAUTION

ALWAYS BLOW DUST OR DEBRIS FROM LENSES PRIOR TO USING ANY CLOTH OR LENS PEN. FAILURE TO DO THIS MAY RESULT IN SCRATCHING OF THE LENSES.

- Cleaning - Keep your lenses clear by using a soft cloth (provided) or lens pen.
- Protect your lenses by using the provided rubber bikini cover during storage and transport.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

POI changes between groups

- Ensure half-inch nut [F] torqued to 65 in-lbs.
- Check/Clean your firearm.
- Check for variations in ammunition.
